



Notice of Temporary Closure of Twenty One French Dining

The Hilton Tokyo's management confirms that the Japan Fair Trade Commission commenced an investigation at the Hilton Tokyo on September 9, in regard to suspected misrepresentations of the provenance of some items on the hotel's Twenty One restaurant menu.

The hotel management takes this matter very seriously, and has decided to suspend operations at its Twenty One restaurant until further notice.

The allegations refer specifically to the example of Maesawa beef fillet on the menu of Twenty One which was replaced with Yamagata beef fillet.

The hotel management team is currently conducting an investigation into this matter and intends to fully cooperate with the local authorities.

Hilton deeply regrets any confusion and inconvenience this causes its valued customers and is putting in place a series of measures to ensure there is no recurrence of these issues.
